Earth Day Event - A Walk for Mother Earth is planned from Sears Island to the Belfast Common, on Saturday, April 21. Participants are welcome to walk, or bicycle for all or part of this ten-mile journey, and planned stops along the route (at 1, 3, and 5 miles) will allow for both shuttling and parking so everyone can participate. People can walk the final mile by joining us on the east end of the footbridge around 2 pm. Gather at the causeway leading to Sears Island at 8:00 am for an opening circle that will include acknowledging the ancestral territory of the Wabanaki people and their caretaking of this land and waters The march will make its way to the Belfast footbridge and along the Harbor walk, to the Belfast Common to enjoy the park, the Phineas Parkhurst Quimby Labyrinth, and a community picnic (BYO). Volunteers are needed as greeters for those who've participated in the Walk for Mother Earth and children's activities helpers during the picnic on Saturday, April 21st. Donations of baked goods are also welcome for this event. Please see Judy Williams if you'd like to volunteer or contribute baked goods. Thank you.
